Red Letter Living – Part 3

Matthew 5:7-9

January 26, 2025

"Blessed are the <u>merciful</u>, for they will be shown mercy.

Blessed are the <u>pure in heart</u>, for they will see God.

Blessed are the <u>peacemakers</u>, for they

will be called the children of God."

— Matt. 5:7-9

Merciful (from Hebrew *chesedh*) – the ability to get inside another person's skin, to see with their eyes and to feel what they feel; to experience things together with another person.

<u>Life Principle</u>: There is always a reason why people act as they do. If we know the reason, it is easier to understand and forgive.

- > Jesus' incarnation is the ultimate expression of being merciful.
- > "Blessed are those who get inside other people...feeling what they feel and seeing what they see; others will do the same for them!"

Pure (katharos) - clean; sifted; undiluted or unmixed

- ➤ This beatitude demands us to do careful <u>self-examination</u>.
- Q Do I do what I do because I want to know and please God?

> "Blessed is the man whose motives and values are entirely unmixed."

For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are <u>fully</u> <u>committed to him.</u> – 2 Chron. 16:9 NIV

<u>Peace</u> (shalom) – everything which makes for a person's highest good; not just the absence of trouble, but the enjoyment of good.

- ➤ The blessing is for peace-makers, not for <u>peace-lovers</u>.
- ▶ Peace that the Bible calls blessed does not come from <u>avoiding issues</u>.
- ➤ Peace-making is a God-like activity. It is what God would do.
- ➤ One who divides is doing the devil's work; one who unites people is doing God's work.
