FEAR OF MISSING OUT

Face to Face – Part 1 (From Fear to Freedom) Luke 1:5-25, 57-58 December 1, 2024

When Zechariah saw him,

<u>he was startled and was gripped with fear.</u>

– Luke 1:12 NIV

1. Everyone experiences gaps in their lives where they feel they are missing out.

Both of them were righteous in the sight of God, observing all the Lord's commands and decrees blamelessly. But they were childless because Elizabeth was not able to conceive, and they were both very old. – Luke 1:6-7 NIV

- It is better to know God than to know why.
- 2. God acts when His people pray.

But the angel said to him: "Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to call him John." – Luke 1:13 NIV

Zechariah continued to <u>pray</u> and <u>serve</u> <u>God</u> despite huge disappointments.

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks

finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." – Matt. 7:7-8 NIV

3. Even a <u>little faith</u> brings about big results.

Zechariah said to the angel, "<u>How can I know that</u> what you say is true? I am an old man, and my wife is also old." – Luke 1:18 ERV

Zechariah no longer really expected God to <u>answer</u> <u>his prayers</u>.

"I tell you the truth, if you had <u>faith even as small</u> <u>as a mustard seed</u>, you could say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it would move. <u>Nothing would be impossible</u>." – Matt. 17:20 NLT

4. God's answers are better than our hopes.
